The fast paced, tough defensive-minded ladies from Naz have paved the way for excellence and are working to rebuild the once proud tradition of Nazareth College Women's Basketball.

Coach Gotham wants his teams known for their defensive intensity (*finished in top 27 for three defensive NCAA statistical categories this past year*) and fundamentally sound approach to the game. He has helped his players to develop to their full potential, while employing a motion offense where those players are able to fully use their abilities. This will be the second year of the "College Prosepect's Camp" and he hopes it becomes a camp where campers become future collegiate student-athletes.
