SUE BEHME: The Head Women's Lacrosse Coach at Nazareth College. Coach Behme is in her ninth season as coach of the Golden Flyers. She has been named Empire 8 Conference Coach of the Year four times. In 2000 she was selected to Co-Coach the prestigious North-South All-Star Game in Towson, Maryland.

The Golden Flyers have been nationally ranked each of the last eight seasons and have won four conference titles while making six NCAA appearances and two ECAC appearances.

A graduate of Cortland, Behme was a two-time All-American in lacrosse and an All-American on the 1992 National Championship Soccer team.

TRACILIAN: The head women's lacrosse coach at SUNY Brockport, Traci Lian is a 2000 Nazareth graduate and was a standout in both lacrosse and field hockey. She led the Golden Eagles to a 13-5 record in 2007.

THE STAFF: The staff will consist of college and high school coaches as well as current and former collegiate All-Americans and players.
